
YogaiaPeace Ceremony at Enchanted Rock

Ceremony will take place from 1:00-3:30 p.m.

There will be ample time after the ceremony to enjoy hiking and quiet intimacy with earth, sky, and heart. Some may want to stay until sunset to watch the full moon rise

What to bring:

lunch and snacks
yoga blanket and/or matt
pillow or backjack chair to sit comfortably
journal
water bottle
hiking shoes
flashlight
a flower and a small piece of fruit for the ceremonial alter
an open mind and open heart

What to wear:

loose comfortable clothing for gentle movement layers for changing weather ~if you hike up the rock, it can be cool and windy hiking shoes

Where to park:

There is separate parking at the private pavilion reserved for our group. You don't have to hike in. The pavilion is covered and has electricity and bathroom facilities.

Ceremony Location: Special reserved pavilion at Enchanted Rock

Directions: Enchanted Rock is located just outside of Fredericksburg.

From Fredericksburg, going west on main street, go though town and turn right on Milam Road. There will be a sign for Enchanted Rock.

Stay on this road approximately 22 miles. You will see the rock and the entrance on the left. Drive to the entrance gate. **There is an entrance fee of \$6 per person**. Park Ranger will direct you to the reserved private pavilion where we will gather.
